'Glow in the dark' sticks/rings etc, Snack food and ice blocks for sale, Polaroid photos too! Water free! Bring coins. Prices 50c - \$3.

For everyone's safety, each child attending needs to be signed in and out of the Disco by his/her parent. If you're sharing rides, please bring a parent-signed note to the Door People on the night. This process does mean queues, so come prepared. If wet, bring an umbrella!
