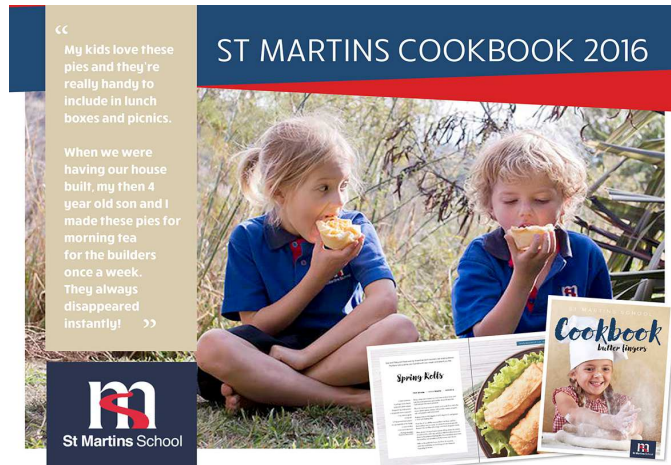
Inaugural St Martins School Fiesta meeting! Tuesday 10th May 7:30 pm at Brickworks
