Safety and Rules

Welcome to Garden to Table

At Garden to Table (GTT) we take safety and rules very seriously, we put these in place for the safety for all the people working in the kitchen and hall.

Knives;

You must always use claw fingers when using knives for safety and when you carry knives they must always be held downwards by your side.

Grating;

You must always watch as you grate and concentrate at all times when grating. Always carry carefully back to the kitchen. When grating, chopping or cutting you must always use a chopping board.

Hot Liquids;

Always be aware there are hot liquids around. When you are front of house always let people know when you are carrying hot drinks by saying in a loud voice "hot liquid coming through", always walk when carrying hot liquids.

Front of House;

FOH students only, allowed in the kitchen with parent / supervisor help when doing their jobs. Other students can go into the kitchen when cleaning up but only 4 at one time with helper.

Moving around the hall;

We always walk and never run in the hall at GTT times and our voices are always inside voices.

Toilets/Drinking;

You must always ask your Teacher before you do either of these things, the same as you would in your classroom.

Activities/Word Seaches/Recipes;

These must be glued into your GTT book. All glue sticks and coloured pencils must be put back into their containers. Blu Tac must be left on sheets / tables or wherever else it it, it must not be taken away from the hall.

Set up for eating;

Front of house will get out all the plates and cutlery for each group which will be elft out for you but you are reponsible to set up your own group table with chairs, plates and cutlery and you must put it all away at the end and wash your own dishes and put these away to.

Please listen and follow the instructions of your supervisor/parent help/Year 7/8 and Teacher.
