#1. Nice and easy! Please start stockpiling your brown paper bags (from Countdown online deliveries or the like) so we can have the students decorate for us to use.




#2. Having a sort out? Think about putting aside any books or quality household items for our white elephant sale. Good used clothing will be collected too.
