SCHOOL UPDATE

Last week the NE to Y2 children had the opportunity to participate in a Travis Wetlands programme. The trip focused on why we need the wetlands, what they look like and some of the creatures that live there. The children had several fun experiences such as bird watching, fishing for water bugs, role play and feeding the eels. Thank you to the parents able to join us on the trips.

This week we have been fortunate to be working with Caroline the Resource Teacher of Literacy further developing our understanding and putting into practice aspects of Structured Literacy. Caroline has been in the school for four days this week modelling, sharing and engaging the teachers in discussion. All teachers are putting some Structured Literacy aspects into their weekly programmes. This looks different throughout the school as we meet the needs of the age and stage of the children.

Next week the Y5 – 8 children will start their winter sports competition. We have the majority of children playing in a local competition this year. This means that most children will walk to and from their games at local venues. The Y7 / 8 netball teams will continue to participate in the Hagley Sports competition. Games are held on a Thursday afternoon, we are hoping that we continue with this lovely weather and that you may be able to join us at times throughout the season.

Good luck to the Y5 – 8 Zone Cross Country team competing next week. The team have been keeping up their fitness with daily (well almost) running sessions this term.

Next Friday the children in Explorers 1 will be sharing their learning with us in our assembly. As usual we will also be celebrating with children receiving values based certificates. The assembly times are;
