## CLASS PLACEMENTS

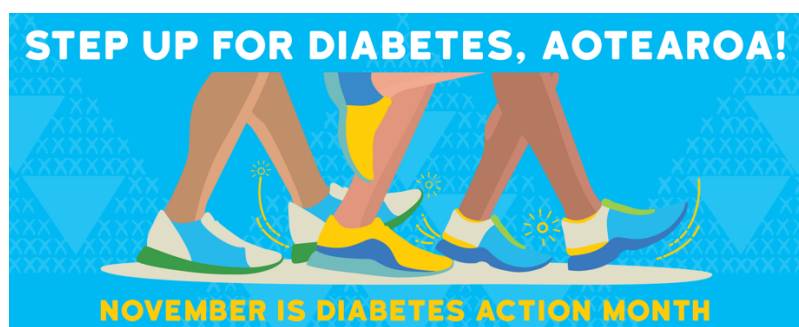

## COVID UPDATES

The Public Health Order (PHO) is now in place. As a school we are able to assure all families that we are meeting the requirements of the PHO.

The Ministry of Education has shared further information regarding vaccinations for whānau supporting in the school setting.

Example	Do they need to meet the PHO vaccination requirements?
Parents or caregivers dropping off, picking up, or settling children at a school	<b>No.</b> The Order does not apply to people who are visiting the school.
Parents or caregivers attending meetings or events on site (e.g. for parent-teacher interviews)	<b>No.</b> The Order does not apply to people who are visiting the school.
Parents, caregivers or volunteers at an EOTC programme, excursion or event	<b>Yes.</b> These people are required to be vaccinated because they are carrying out work (unpaid) at or for a school they may have contact with children or students or will be present at a time when children and students are also present.
Parents, caregivers and members of the community who are volunteers at a school	<b>Yes.</b> These people are required to be vaccinated because they are carrying out work (unpaid) at or for a school and they may have contact with children or students or will be present at a time when children and students are also present.  If the volunteer is working offsite and will not have any contact with children or students as part of their role, then they are not required to be vaccinated.

## DROP OFF AND PICK UP

A reminder that the guidelines remain the same for drop off / pick up and gatherings.

The preferred option is for this to occur outside with parents using social distancing of 2m. If you are coming onsite, sign in using the tracer app and wear a mask. If you are entering the classroom space ensure you fill in the paper contact form.

## GATHERINGS

At this point in time the MoE prefer schools use the gathering rule of a max of 100 inside / outside. This rule comes into practice when we are joined by whānau who may be observing / spectating (anything other than supporting the learning or an EOTC event). This means that we are unable to offer the opportunity for families to spectate at the Explorers and Discoverers Athletic events. Without the hall we are also rethinking what we can offer in the way of end of year assemblies.

## PROPERTY UPDATE

The Ministry of Education have placed the PHO requirements on all contractors working on school sites. This has meant that our team working on the hall has been reduced to one person at this point in time. The hall unfortunately will not be ready for the end of the year, we look forward to a new year with a larger space. The new build work will see some demolition starting in the next few weeks.

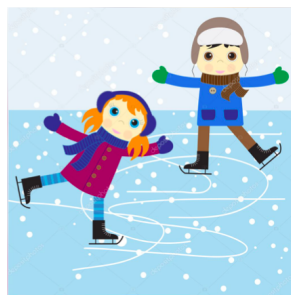
