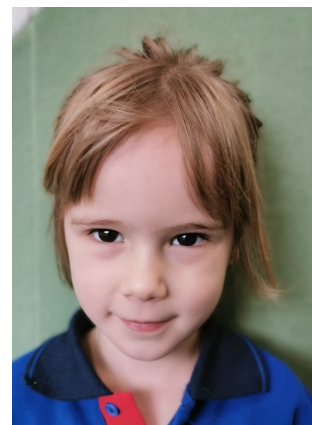
I enjoyed the opportunity to see the Y7 / 8 EPAC team on the stage at the town hall last week and look forward to seeing the recorded version when it is released.

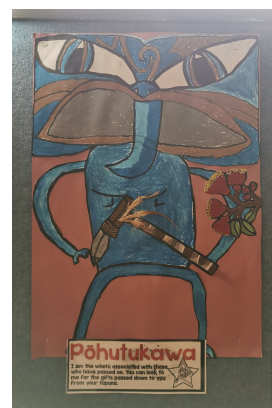


COVID UPDATE

Thank you to the Year 5-8 children for your positive response going back to masks this week.

As you'll be aware, the Ministry of Education still asks us to have ventilation in the classrooms during the winter months. We are asked that windows are being kept ajar in these cold winter days, but continue to have heat pumps on to keep rooms warm. We currently have 7 purifiers in some classrooms, which also helps keep classes clean and warm.

With the current cold temperatures, we respect that your child requires extra warmth. For this reason, thermals can be worn under uniforms. We are also happy for jackets to be worn if needed. Year 8 students are allowed to wear their hoodies underneath their Senior Jackets Monday to Thursday. Due to Health and Safety reasons, they cannot wear hoodies on Friday's at Technology.
