# SCHOOL UPDATE

It was great to have the children outside yesterday and see the sunshine at the end of the day. Let's hope we can get some more fine weather (perhaps August will be better than the wettest July since records began in 1943) so we can have more skipping happening through structured learning time as well as break times. We are looking forward to our skipping day later in the term.

Thank you to the parents who were able to join teachers for the learning conferences in week ten last term. We hope you found these beneficial to be able to have a follow up conversation on your child's written report. There was a good uptake of our hybrid model with families using all of the face to face, online, children attending or not attending options.

This term we welcome Cate, Theo, Dom, Nina, Zoe, Felix, Ollie and Penny to St Martins School | Hato Mātene. We hope you enjoy your time with us and look forward to your contributions to school.

Last week we shared that the Y5 - 8 children would continue in masks for the winter months. This was followed up by the strong recommendation and request from the MoE that all Y4 - 8s were to be in masks for the first four weeks of the term. We have put this request in place and are providing masks for those that do not have their own. Ventilation through opening windows, air purifiers and providing hand sanitising continue to be a part of our protection against covid.

Looking at the calendar for the term we have lots on. Wonderful to see events like the Koru Games coming back after a two year absence. In advance we thank all of the parents who will join us for the trips and events through the term. The Y3 / 4 team are looking forward to their 'Grow Your Mind Day' in week 7 this term. We look forward to parents sharing their expertise in the workshops.

This term the Y5/6 children will be going to camp in week 8. Megan and Hamish have been working together to put in a funding application to reduce the cost. We are pleased to be able to share with you that we have received \$10,000 in outside funding for this camp. We are able to reduce the cost from \$200 per student to \$140 for this camp. for camp before Monday 14th Sept, there is also the opportunity to make weekly payments if you would prefer, please contact Megan for details around this.
