SCHOOL UPDATE

Kia ora koutou.

This week we welcome Emma, Emmett, Freya and Toby. We hope that you enjoy your time at St Martins | Hato Mātene and look forward to sharing in your learning experiences.

We have had our first couple of EOTC trips for the year with our Playground Activity Leaders meeting with other schools for a day last week and yesterday we had the school mural group joining Jackie in town to look at the Shift Urban Art Takeover exhibition in the Canterbury Museum displays to get inspiration for our creative in schools project, adding colour to the top courts. Thank you to the whānau members able to support the children with the trip.

A number of whānau in our community will have family affected by Cyclone Gabrielle in the North Island. Our thoughts are with you, if there is any support we can offer as a school please reach out to us. Along with other schools in Canterbury we will be having a uniform free day raising funds for affected kura. Our theme is simply freestyle Friday. This week your child will have brought a notice home regarding the Paid Union Meetings (PUM) next week - Thursday 2 March - if you are available, could you please collect your child / children from school at 12.30. Children who are remaining at school will have an adapted programme for the afternoon, quite possibly a waiata and movie. Could you please return the information slip to your child's classroom teacher so they will know whether your child is being collected, walking home or staying at school. If you did not receive the letter please check HERO for a digital copy.

Last year we started working with Juliette Hayes from the Education Review Office (ERO). The review framework has changed in the last few years. We no longer have an ERO team onsite for a few days and then given a review of three or five years. Every school across the motu has









a facilitator like Juliette who they work closely with during a three year cycle. At the beginning of the three years the facilitator writes a profile page about the school. This has now been confined and will be on the ERO website. We will also link this on the school website.

As we start the new year, it's a timely reminder about keeping our children safe at school drop off and pick up.

If you are dropping your child off, please remember the following:

- park in designated areas (e.g 5 minute drop off / pick up area)
- no parking on yellow lines (particularly by the road patrol area)
- no u-turns by the road patrol area

We understand the congestion during these times can make parking difficult, however keeping our children and community safe is top priority.

If you have any concerns around parking around the school, then the **Snap, Send, Solve** app is an effective way to report these. Ka pai te wiki mutanga.
