




St Martins School | Te Kura o Hato Mātene Newsletter 3 : 9 Mar 2022

St Martins School Sports Tees

At St Martins School we have a sports tees that we loan to children for various sporting activities that they are competing in on behalf of the school and also for Thursday sports teams. There is a charge for the hire of these for Thursday sport etc.

We would like to be able to make these available for Year 5 to 8 students to purchase their own tee shirt so that they are not relying on the school for a tee shirt/each time an event comes up. Along with the house tees orders that we are taking at this point in time, we would like to start an order for sports tees. We could also make available the sports shorts.

A Year 5 student could have the use of their own tee shirt for 4 years at the one off price of \$20..00 each rather than paying each year for the hire of one.

We understand that not all students will require one but if you know your child will be competing in various sporting events such as korfball, athletics, kiwi tag, koru games, orienteering to name a few, plus football for Thursday sport, plus representing the school for another reason then this might be an ideal solution.
