The school is exceptionally appreciative of the aspects the PTA are putting into place, we look forward to being able to use some of these funds for future enhancements of the school.

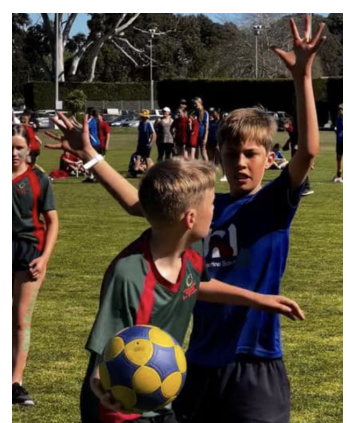

We are looking forward to our Wearable Arts event in week two next term. We will be having four shows, two for each syndicate (Y0 - 4 / Y5 - 8). Show times are:

at school 30 minutes before the show starts so we have time to get children into their creations.

This term we are starting the preparations for the 2024 class organisation. Class placements involve a number of discussions to enable us to make the best decisions for each student. We take into consideration a number of factors, meeting together on numerous occasions to discuss the make-up of groupings. At St Martins School | Hato Mātene we have mixed ability classes. We use the following definition for placing children: groups of children working at similar levels - with consideration of ages, social, behavioural and emotional aspects. As with previous years we extend an invitation to you, as parents, to make us aware of any information that might be relevant to the placement of your child / children. This is an opportunity to give us information that will help us with our process, it is not an invitation to select your child's 2024 teacher. Please be aware that there is a close off for this information – **Friday October 13 2023**. Please use the [link to the survey to share your information](#). If you have children to enrol or are transitioning to another school could you please let the office know.

The NZ curriculum is currently being refreshed. We have started by adding a focus on the Aotearoa NZ Histories curriculum as a section of the Social Sciences curriculum and are next moving on to the Maths and Literacy curriculum. With the refresh the Ministry of Education has allocated four staff only days. These need to be taken during certain times of the year. Our curriculum refresh staff only day will be Thursday November 16. This is inline with the schools in our Kahui Ako | Cluster including Cashmere High. School will be closed on this day.
