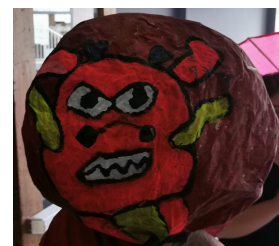

- Mending holes etc - priced on item

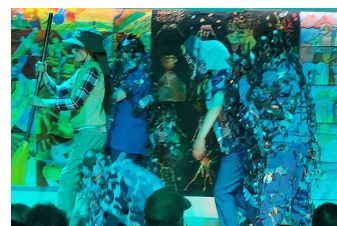
Simply place the clean items in a bag and drop it into the box provided in the school office. Please include the following information with your items:
