This week we welcome Eilish, Eleanor, Miller, Rhys (rm 4) Saskia (rm 12) and Hanna (rm 11). We look forward to you Kia ora whānau, being a part of the St Martins | Hato Mātene whānau, the learning you will engage in and the contributions you will make.

Welcome back to the final term of the school year. I hope that everyone had a safe and enjoyable holiday break. It sounds like our tamariki had great fun during the two week break. With the warm weather we had it was great to hear that lots of children spent the time outdoors.

As a teaching staff we had a Teacher only day on the first Monday of the break. This was used to look at both the Maths and Literacy draft curriculums. As a team we discussed the key changes and concepts. This term the Maths and Literacy teams will delve into the resources that the Government is offering schools as well as updating our planning to implement the aspects from the new curriculum. Next year we will probably see a change in our reporting as we move from a curriculum that is levelled to a curriculum that has three phases. The phases are:

- Phase 1 = Y0 3
- Phase 2 = Y4 6
- Phase 3 = Y7 8

We will be using our Government allocated Teacher only day on **Monday 18 November** to discuss and develop programmes of implementation of the new curriculum to meet the criteria to have these in place and being used at the start of term one, 2025. Keep an eye on the online calendar this term, we have a lot of exciting events happening across the kura, this could be inside the school eg sharing of Y5 / 6 passion projects, christmas concerts or outside the classroom eg athletics, swimming, Y8 amazing race. As we enter the summer months, a reminder that all students need to be wearing a hat as part of the uniform. Y0 - 7 children need to wear the school bucket hat while the Y8 children are able to wear a bucket hat of their choosing.

We roll into the final 40 days of schooling at St Martins | Hato Mātene for our lovely Y8 group. We hope you make the most of this time and get involved in all the exciting activities that are planned. We have a number of educational events and experiences planned both in the classroom and beyond, and I encourage all of you to embrace these opportunities.

Such a lovely morning to spend some time at Hansen Park for athletics training. I think I'll pop down and have a look.
